#### What inspired you to start making music?

My inspiration to begin making music was based on God giving me the gift of song, and also showing me over time that the gift He gave wasn't just to keep for myself! The Word tells us that everything God made was good, and I began to look at the way He created the earth. If God created the earth, surely there's creativity that He placed within those He created to be used to bring glory to His Name. And, THAT'S when my perspective changed and I began to start writing & creating more.

#### How would you describe your sound/style, and how has it evolved over time?

Man! I would describe my sound/style as a mixture, honestly. I am truly a worshiper at heart! At the same time, I also have an R&B sound to my voice, too. Over time I believe my sound has matured with teachings of others, learning to make a song my own & not feeling a need to mimic the artist who may be singing it, as well as learning to try new things in music/singing. #### What challenges have you faced in the music industry so far, and how have you overcome them?

A couple of challenges I'd say that I have faced so far in the music industry would definitely be financial challenges, challenges to bring to life vision, and ideas that I have with whomever I may be working with at the time, and challenged in the area of believing that what I am creating and sharing with the world is worth hearing sometimes. Sometimes it doesn't matter how much confidence you carry, the enemy will absolutely try to fight you on that and make you feel that what you have to offer won't seem worth much. How I've overcome is by continuing to be open to teachings and not allowing fear to cause me to feel defeated, but do it regardless!

#### Can you walk me through your creative process when you're working on a new project?

So, my creative process mostly stems from hearing a sound. When I hear certain sounds, it's almost like a breeding ground for lyrics to come! This song initially started from sitting in a service years ago, and the musician was just flowing. I pulled out my phone and just begin to sing "I am waiting on You... I won't stop til You move.." I had no idea that this would end up

being my very first song years later! From there, God led me to the story of Jacob and I began to write. Even when I'm writing jingles for other people, it's always the sound or sounds that I hear that seems to pull out lyrics. I always pray before I begin writing anything! And, when I get stuck, I stop, put it down and come back to it in another day or two to finish it up. I also ask for help if I can't seem to think of anything at all or draw a blank. Then there are other times when I may be asleep and hear a sound in a dream and wake up and record the sound that I hear so that I can go back and revisit to see if it's something I should write from. So, imagine my voice memos... lol

#### This project, what were you thoughts concerning writing this song and what is the message that you want to convey?

My thoughts concerning writing this song at first were not solid, because at first I had no idea what I was singing—I only sang what I heard. And, what I heard at the time didn't catch up to me until years later when I found myself in Jacob's shoes, walking through the lyrics of the song. The message I desire to convey is that 1.
